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## Introduction

Guildford and Kalamunda Districts Swimming Club is a family based swimming club with a high number of junior members. It is important for the welfare of all our members that a Code of Conduct designed to promote a safe environment is adhered to by all. All swimmers, coaches, members, parents, or anyone attending club functions must abide by the Code of Conduct.

## Attending club functions/events

Our facilities are private facilities not open to the public, attending club events such as meets, training, busy-bees etc are as either members or guests of the club. Failure to abide by the Code of Conduct may result in your access to the facilities being revoked. It is not a requirement to be a member to be bound by the Code of Conduct, all visitors must also abide by the Code of Conduct.

## Code of Conduct for Swimmers, Parents, Coaches, and Visitors.

1. At all times be courteous and show respect to other swimmers, coaches, officials and parents.
2. Obscene or abusive language, obscene gestures, bullying and offensive remarks can bring the swimmer, the Club and the sport into disrepute and will not be tolerated.
3. To be reliable. That is to fulfil all commitments to training, competitions and to the Coach.
4. Do not engage in unsportsmanlike behaviour. That is obey all swimming rules, be respectful of fellow competitors, be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat.
5. Alcohol, tobacco or other illicit drug use or possession is strictly prohibited within the vicinity of the pool at training or at competitions. Swimmers found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will face disciplinary action.
6. Remember you are an ambassador for the Swimming Club. In return for the personal gains that membership affords you, it is essential that you adhere to the Code of Conduct at all times.

## Membership

As part of becoming a member you are required to agree to a set of Terms and Conditions. These Terms and Conditions are displayed during the membership process, and available on our website. If you do-not agree with the Terms and Conditions you should not proceed with your membership. If you need to review them they are available on our website.

## Terms and Conditions

1. I agree to abide by the rules, regulations and policies of Swimming WA, Swimming Australia, the relevant Regional Swimming Association and the relevant club, including Swimming Australia's Anti-Doping, Member Protection and Privacy Policies (these are available at [www.swimming.org.au](http://www.swimming.org.au)).
2. I authorise Swimming WA and the club to use and disclose to related and relevant bodies any of my personal information that may be necessary to implement the rules, regulations and policies in 1. above. I agree to have my name, results and any photograph taken during events conducted by Swimming WA or the club, unless I or any Guardian indicate otherwise, published in official programs, newsletters and websites and other media.
3. It is the parents/guardians responsibility to ensure children are supervised at all times if there are any medical conditions that may require attention.
4. Training fees **must** be paid in advance by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. Please note the monthly training fees are payable regardless of number of sessions attended (1 or 20+).
5. The submitter of this Registration is the responsible delegate of the swimmer for all payments to Guildford and Kalamunda Districts Swimming Club.
6. This online registration will include all fees associated with providing affiliation with Swimming WA and associated insurance, as well as the annual club membership fees.
